## AWESOME AMPHIBIANS

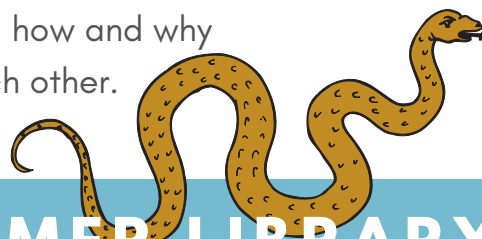
We sure love our slimy friends! Learn what amphibians are, meet live frogs and find out why amphibians are important contributors to the environment.
